

GOOD LAUNDRY PRACTICE

WASHERS

- Load to correct level.
- Wash darks and lights separately.
- Use the correct temperature and program.
- Use thermal disinfection on foul linen.
- Use prewash when required.
- Use de-stainer on stained items.
- Never use softener on kylies or microfibres.
- Do not interrupt process.

PUMPS

- Are they pumping?
- Are the chemicals moving?
- Report any leaks.

LINEN

- Handle soiled linen with gloves.
- Keep soiled and clean linen in separate containers.
- Never put linen on the floor.
- Classify correctly.
- Iron or smooth and fold while warm.
- Store clean linen hygienically.

DRYER

- Clean lint trap before each shift.
- It is a fire hazard if the lint trap is not cleaned regularly.
- Select cool down option when drying polycottons.
- Do not over-dry as it causes static.

PRODUCT DRUMS

- Are they pumping?
- Are the chemicals moving?
- Report any leaks.

HOUSE KEEPING

- Clean all equipment, floors and machines regularly.
- Report any faults to supervisor or manager.
- Never leave hot linen over night as it can cause a fire hazard.
