

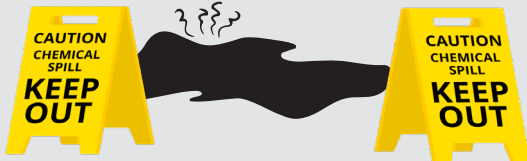
WHEN A SPILL OCCURS

IDENTIFY SPILL SITUATION

Consider the worst until the spilled product is identified



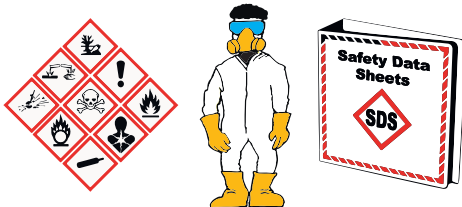

SECURE THE AREA

Approach cautiously -
make sure the air direction over the spill area
is away from you
Keep people away -
set up barriers and barricades

IDENTIFY THE HAZARD

Wear protective gear -
choose appropriate personal protection for the situation
Safety Data Sheets -
look up & references SDS
Evacuate area -
for non-essential & unqualified personnel

PERFORM SPILL CONTROL

Stop leak -
close valves, plug leaks, move containers
Contain spill -
reduce the spreading spill & seal drains
Clean up spill -
use appropriate spill control products & equipment for clean up

COMMUNICATE THE INCIDENT

Report the spill -
contact the proper local legal authorities & agencies
Document the spill -
fill out & complete all report in accordance with local laws

REMOVE SPILL CONTROL PRODUCTS

Contain used spill control products -
for disposal in accordance with local laws
Decontaminate equipment & area -
clean all reusable equipment to be ready for re-use
Prepare documents for shipment of used spill products -
in accordance with local laws

EVALUATE AREA

Make a determination -
identify if the area is safe for regular use again
Record the incident -
detail spill incident in on-site log & file documentation
Review company procedures and contingency plans -
in accordance with local laws



REMEMBER

Life Safety is the most important consideration
